This morning we will be visiting the Queen Victoria Market a historic landmark spread over two city blocks Officially opened 20 March 1878, the market has been serving people of Melbourne for over 140 years. The market has seen many transformations and extensions now with over 600 small businesses selling Australian fresh fruit and vegetables, local and imported gourmet foods, clothing, souvenirs and freshly cooked food. It has also made it to the National Heritage List. Next we will embark on an unforgettable exploration of Melbourne's waterfront, a unique way of seeing and learning about Melbourne's huge range of sites up and down stream of the Yarra River. This relaxing two hour cruise highlights the city's iconic landmarks, vibrant ports, serene river gardens and captivating natural beauty. Landmarks such as Federation Square, Royal Botanical Gardens, Melbourne Arena, MCG, Herrington Island, Docklands, Shipping channels just to name a few. This afternoon we will make our way along South Bank, past the Crown Casino and across the river to Sealife Melbourne Aquarium, a Southern Ocean and Antarctic aquarium with over 10,000 live sea creatures on display.
