Day #1 Wednesday 2nd October 2024

Pickup Passengers from their homes, travel to Launceston airport where we will board our late afternoon flight to Adelaide via Melbourne. Check into accommodation and have a late dinner. *Overnight Rydges South Park Adelaide* (D)



Day #2 Thursday 3rd October 2024

Delicious buffet breakfast to start the day. We board the coach and make our way to Victor Harbor, but first we will be stopping at German Village of Hahndorf. Here you will have free time to explore Hahndorf's main street with many specialty shops and galleries full of local crafts and produce and pubs where you can sample some German Beers. Grab a bite to eat for an early lunch before continuing our way through Mount Compass stopping at Harvest the Fleurieu a family owned and operated strawberry farm, market hall and café. Here you will get the opportunity to hand pick your own strawberries and grab a cuppa. Upon arrival into Victor Harbor we will stop at the Visitors Information Centre where we will wander through the South Australian Whale Museum. Here you will learn about Victor Harbors and surrounds have a rich history of whaling export history. Checking into our hotel where we will call home for the next 3 nights. Two course dinner is to be had at the on site bistro.

Day #3 Friday 4th October 2024

An exciting day today as we start with a ride on the historic Horse

Drawn Tram across the Causeway to Granite Island. The Tramway commenced operation in
1894 and is one of two remaining in the world that operate a daily service. Here we will meet
the beautiful Clydesdale horses and board our chariot to Granite Island. We will also be lucky
enough to meet and greet these stunning horses in their stables and learn all about how they are
trained and what is involved with pulling the tram. After morning tea we will visit Victor
Harbor's National Trust Museum. Here we will be guided through the old Victor Harbor
Station Master's Residence through their three galleries forming a timeline from pre-European
settlement, whaling settlement and the establishment of Port Victor, the river trade and finally
the onset of tourism in the 20th Century with the railways. You will have the opportunity to purchase your own lunch in town before we meet our driver and board the coach for an afternoon
of touring Port Elliot, Middleton Beach and Encounter Bay. Our driver will share their
local knowledge of the areas and point out places of interest, stopping at the best places which
offer picturesque views of the coastal landscapes. Free evening tonight in Victor Harbor.

Day #4 Saturday 5th October 2024

A relaxed start to the day, having breakfast at your own leisure and enjoy some free time. You may wish to sleep in or wander to the local farmers market in town. The group will meet at the Victor Harbor train station where we will board the Cockle steam Train for a 30 minute ride along the coastal cliffs of Encounter Bay and along side the River Murray to Goolwa.

After lunch (own expense) we will meet our driver who will drive us to Hindmarsh Island, a river island that is located in the lower Murray River. Enjoying the air conditioning in the coach and a view from higher up we will continue our way to the Murray Mouth Lookout, here you will see where the Murray River meets the Ocean. Our driver will then take us back around Goowla and onto the Barrage which is the ocean side of the Murray Mouth. After an exciting day of touring, walks and stunning coastlines we will enjoy a two course dinner at our accommodation. *Overnight Night Caps Hotel Victor* (B, D)

Day #5 Sunday 6th October 2024

This morning we leave the beautiful Fleurieu Peninsula and make our way to Murray Bridge. Our first stop for the day is the old Tailmen Town Pioneer Village. The town was established in 1982 with their doors opening to the public in 1987. Since then becoming Australia's largest pioneer village showcasing over



110 furnished buildings within their periods for all to enjoy. We then make our way to Monarto Safari Park where we will be treated to lunch before a personalied guided tour of the large open safari park in the comfort of our own air conditioned coach. Our final leg for the day, free time to purchase your own dinner in Murray Bridge before boarding the Proud Mary River Boat, our home for the next 6 days. Our five night cruise departs from Murray Bridge where we will be welcomed aboard by the friendly Proud Mary crew. Enjoy a delicious supper at approximately 8:00pm as we cruise this evening and the Proud Mary's powerful floodlights illuminate the shore. It is a perfect opportunity to view the nocturnal animals of Australia in their natural habitat. Later the Proud Mary ties up for the night at Woodlane.

Day #6 Monday 7th October 2024

Our cruise continues upstream as we enjoy a delicious breakfast before a mid-morning Proud Mary arrival in picturesque Mannum, the birthplace of the river boat trade. Here you may board the awaiting coach for an interesting tour of the Historic Mannum. Our guide will provide you with information. Lunch will be served aboard the Proud Mary as you cruise upstream to Walkers Flat. This evening is "Australiana Night" featuring typically Australian dishes. Followed by a guided Nocturnal Discover Tour, an insight into abundant wildlife including the Southern Hairy Nosed Wombat.

Overnight on board the Proud Mary (B, L, D)

Day #7 Tuesday 8th October 2024

After breakfast the Proud Mary cruises further upstream. In the afternoon arrive Swan Reach and board the coach for a tour to Costa Brothers Almond Farm. Discover how this state of the art almond farm uses water-recycling technology to limit its direct impact on the river system and help secure the diverse ecosystem of the river. Also visit the Swan Reach Museum which is housed in the original school building that was built in 1917.

Our cruise this evening takes you to Sugar Shack. Sugar Shack is part of the River Murray International Dark Sky Reserve which is an astronomer's paradise. The unpolluted skies and isolation from artificial light sources make the park one of the best places on earth to gaze at the stars. *Overnight on board the Proud Mary (B, L, D)*

Day #8 Wednesday 9th October 2024

We will wake this morning in one of the most unspoilt and picturesque areas of the River Murray. We will be taken on an environmental discovery walk of Sugar Shack. A highlight of your cruise is a guided cruise lead by an ecologist aboard a small boat through the lagoons and inlets of Big Bend. Catch the sunset as the evening rays glisten and glow on the limestone walls of the Big Bend Cliffs. This evening there is a traditional Australian barbeque on shore followed by live Aussie entertainment around a blazing campfire.

Overnight on board the Proud Mary (B, L, D)

Day #9 Thursday 10th October 2024

You can see the sunrise over the towering cliffs this morning with an early departure to the Ngaut Aboriginal conservation area

where we will be met by our local aboriginal guide and shown over Australia's first Aboriginal Archaeological digs. It contains galleries of Cave Art, smoke stains from ancient fires and an excavated campsite of a civilisation over 8,000 years old. Late afternoon arrive in

Mannum for cocktails, hors d'oeuvres and a formal Captain's

Dinner. Overnight on board the Proud Mary (B, L, D)

Day #10 Friday 11th October 2024

Following breakfast the Proud Mary departs once more. Mid morning arrive in Woodlane and board the awaiting coach for a tour to the Reedy Creek Environment tour. We will be joined by a



guide for a tour of this fascinating area. Discover this permanent watercourse from waterfalls, through swamps and wetlands. Reedy Creek and the waterfalls played a significant part in the lives of the ancient Nganguruku and Ngaralta Aboriginal Tribes. Today, lunch is superbly prepared using fresh local produce. This afternoon there will be more spectacular scenery before the vessel ties up once more in Murray Bridge, the Captain and crew bid farewell to guests and new-found friends before disembarkation at 4.00pm. Our final night together will be spent at the popular Adelaide beach of Glenelg. We will enjoy dinner at our hotel and for those that wish to can watch the sun set over the pier. *Overnight Stamford Grand* (B, L, D)

Day #11 Saturday 12th October 2024

Today after a cooked breakfast we say farewell to this lovely part of Australia, taking pleasant memories of cruising along the Murray River. We will make our way to the airport for our flight back to Launceston via Melbourne. Our Coach Captain will be awaiting to welcome us and deliver us safely home. **B**


