Day 2 Sunday 18th February 2024



Day 6 Thursday 22nd February 2024

This morning we have a couple of choices of the route in which we take to get to our clifftop BBQ Breakfast. A stroll through Palm Glen Reserve, or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. At the end of the walks we meet on the cliff top for a delicious BBQ breakfast. If

Tonight we will enjoy an Island Fish Fry, a feast of Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by Island desserts and tea or coffee.
